They had tried trainers, but nothing seemed to work. They felt that George would do well in a quieter environment. Rescue contacted several families who indicated they would work with George, but all attempts failed. K-9 Karma feels he is a good candidate so he will be on his way to Karma shortly.




Pup Cake

Ingredients:

- 1 egg
- 1/4 cup xylitol-free peanut butter
- 1/4 cup cooking oil
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 cup shredded carrots
- 1 cup whole wheat or white flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda

Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F and grease six cups of a cupcake tin
2. In a large bowl, mix together the egg, peanut butter, oil and vanilla. Once blended, stir in carrots.
3. Whisk together the flour and baking soda in a separate bowl and fold into the batter until just combined.
4. Evenly disperse the batter across the six cupcake tins and bake for 40 minutes.
5. Let the cakes cool for 10 minutes, then allow to cool completely on a wire rack before serving to your pup!
6. Enjoy!
